

At Family Of Faith United Methodist Church, we offer a safe, secure, fun place for children from birth through 7th grade to enjoy fun and fellowship while learning about Jesus. The Children's education department provides learning during the Traditional Service, the Contemporary Service, and Sunday School, but also offers snacks and some fun playtime in our newly renovated Rec Room.

NURSERY

Our nursery is available for newborns until they are potty-trained toddlers. This fun space is staffed by loving, trained volunteers who will provide compassionate care for children while you relax and enjoy a worship service and Sunday School class.

TODDLER CLASS

Toddlers that are potty-trained are welcomed into our Toddler Classroom. In this class, they will participate in many fun activities while they are learning Bible lessons. The Bible lessons are reinforced through puppet play, videos, stories, and hands-on crafts and experiments. Children remain in this classroom through Kindergarten.

ELEMENTARY CLASS

This class is offered for children from 1st through 5th grade. In this class, the school-aged children will begin to dive deeper into their knowledge of the Bible. Each week they will learn Bible basics and be challenged and rewarded for scripture memorization. Fun videos, games, and experiments are used to make learning fun and exciting for everyone.

CONFIRMATION CLASS

The Confirmation Class is offered for children in 6th and 7th grade. This 2-year program will give children the chance to learn more about Family of Faith and the theology of the United Methodist Church as a whole and most importantly the teachings of Jesus. Through coursework, field trips to other churches, mission projects, and a weekend retreat, the students will deepen their knowledge of the Bible and the United Methodist Church. After completing this class the students will be prepared to make the choice to take the important step of confirming their baptism and becoming a member of Family of Faith United Methodist Church.
